Reservation, Deposit and Cancellation Policy

- To secure your reservation a deposit is required – the amount of the deposit is dependent on the nature of your safari.
- The balance will be payable in cash or wire transfer at the end of your safari.
- Should Somerby Safaris receive notification of cancellation of your booking prior than 6 months before the first day of your safari, Somerby Safaris will refund the deposit, less 15%.
- Should Somerby Safaris receive notification of cancellation of your booking prior than 3 months before the first day of your safari, Somerby Safaris will refund the deposit, less 50%.
- Should Somerby Safaris receive notification of cancellation of your booking less than 3 months before the first day of your safari, you will forfeit the full deposit to Somerby safaris.
- Should Somerby Safaris receive notification of cancellation of your booking prior than 6 to 3 months before the first day of your safari, you may choose to transfer the deposit paid to another reservation, commencing on a future date.

Whilst in transit, loss of luggage (whether temporary or permanent) will be the responsibility of the airline carrier and/or yourself. Any costs associated with recovery of lost baggage will be for the client's account. Somerby Safaris will not be liable for any damage or loss of personal items belonging to the client or his/her companions before, during or after the agreed safari dates.
- **Somerby Safaris has to be in possession of your duly completed indemnity waiver prior to your departure for South Africa.**

- The client hereby agrees that a professional hunter may decide to kill an animal that the client has shot, if in his opinion, the wounded animal poses a threat to human life or is suffering in any way.
- The client agrees to pay the full trophy fee in case an animal is shot and draws blood, irrespective of whether the animal is recovered or not.
- The client agrees that photographs and video material taken during the safari may be used by Somerby Safaris for promotion and publicity purposes.
